



United Way of Alamance County's 2024 Grant Timeline





Grant Eligibility

Local public agencies, 501c3 nonprofit organizations, and government authorities may submit one application by the deadline

Previous grantees must be in good standing in order to reapply, i.e. timely and complete reporting

Programs should be based on local data and serve individuals living in Alamance County

Proposals may be in the planning and/or implementation stage

Preference is given to agencies that:
Collaborate with other initiatives and nonprofits and form new relationships
Actively working to eliminate disparities with an equity lens
Engage community members, especially those whose voices have traditionally been marginalized
Has strong outreach techniques to reach vulnerable, underserved, or marginalized populations





Poverty Reduction

Supporting basic human needs: housing, food, healthcare, opportunities for economic mobility

Traditionally excluded communities

Reducing disparities and negative health outcomes

Improving resource coordination





Health

Building healthier, more resilient communities
by promoting physical activity, expanding
access to quality healthcare, integrating health
into early childhood development, and supports
for older adults.

Education

Making sure children start school ready to succeed, become proficient readers from an early age, stay on track in middle school, earn a high school diploma, and pursue higher education.

Financial Stability

Empowering people to get on stable financial ground with access to adequate public transportation and affordable housing, career readiness, and financial literacy.

How do you involve the community in decision-making or program creation?



Identifying Goals & Outcomes

Program Goal

Goals provide programmatic direction, such as an expected outcome that a program is designed to address, these are not measurable -- they set an ideal to work toward. What does your program intend to accomplish? How does your goal align with United Way's priorities?



How does your goal and outcome(s) relate to the problem you are addressing?

Measured Outcome(s)

Provide the desired outcomes your program is attempting to achieve. They should be based on the goal. The outcome(s) must be measurable, time-oriented, specific, and lead to accomplishing a stated goal(s). They should include directional terms (increase, decrease, improve, reduce, etc.), along with the percentage change that is projected to achieve the outcome. You must state at least one measurable outcome (can state multiple).


