HOSPITALITY AND PERSONAL SERVICES

FOOD HANDLING

This course teaches essential food safety skills and prepares students to earn the ServSafe Food Handler Certification. Students learn sanitation, safe food handling, and illness prevention for entry-level food service jobs.

This course prepares students for success in hospitality while earning the Guest Service Gold Certification. Students learn essential customer service skills, communication, and professionalism for entry-level roles in hotels, tourism, and service industries.

Integrated Education and Training CO-ENROLLMENT Guide

DESIGNED WITH YOUR FUTURE IN MIND

Our Integrated Education and Training (IET), or co-enrollment, combines career training with High School Equivalency (HSE) or English as a Second Language (ESL) classes to help students gain job skills and earn industry credentials. Some pathways may require placement testing, and additional support services are available through ACC’s Office of Accessibility Services and the Access to Achievement Initiative.

Course availability varies by semester, and some courses may include additional costs, though scholarships may be available. AGRICULTURE AND LIFE SCIENCES

BIOWORK PROCESS TECHNICIAN

Are you looking for a fresh start in a stable, high-paying field? BioWork is a specialized certificate program designed to prepare you for a career in pharmaceutical manufacturing. In just 136 hours, you can gain the skills needed to become a Process Technician—the professionals who help produce life-saving medicines.



APPLIED ENGINEERING AND INDUSTRIAL TRADES

CONSTRUCTION BOOTCAMP

Launch a career in this high demand field. This course introduces foundational construction skills as identified by local employers, including basic safety, hand and power tools, basic print reading, and various construction materials and techniques. Learning will be enhanced through hands-on application.

HEAVY EQUIPMENT OPERATOR

This program trains students to operate and maintain heavy equipment like excavators, dozers, and loaders. It covers safety, construction concepts, and environmental practices, and aligns with National Center for Construction Education & Research Heavy Equipment Operation credentials.

HVAC

Modern HVAC-R systems are advanced and energy-efficient, creating strong demand for skilled technicians. This hands-on field offers solid career opportunities, including employment, advancement, further education, or personal skill development.

NC SAFETY INSPECTION AND OBD II

Alamance Community College offers short-term training to prepare you for North Carolina vehicle inspector certification, combining focused knowledge with hands-on practice to help you pass the state exam.

PLUMBING

Plumbing is an essential skilled trade. This two-course program at Alamance Community College builds job-ready skills through hands-on, lab-focused training rather than textbook learning.

EDUCATION

EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION

Turn your passion for working with children into a career. This course introduces the foundations of early childhood education and prepares you to plan developmentally appropriate learning experiences. Earn the EDU 119 Certificate and be ready for employment in preschools, daycare centers, or other programs, while building a strong foundation for further study in education.

TEACHER ASSISTANT

This program prepares individuals to become effective teacher assistants by building classroom skills and understanding of student learning. Completing the course and the National Career Readiness Certificate (NCRC) meets North Carolina requirements, and no prior education or teaching experience is needed.



HEALTH AND WELLNESS

EKG TECH

Electrocardiogram (EKG/ECG) technicians use advanced equipment to monitor and record heart activity. This course prepares you for national certification and a vital role in diagnosing heart conditions. Fast-track your entry into a specialized medical field and make a direct impact on patient care.

PHARMACY TECHNICIAN

Pharmacy technicians support pharmacists to ensure safe, efficient medication delivery. This program prepares detail-oriented individuals for fast-paced pharmacy settings, building practical skills for careers in retail, hospital, or clinic environments.

PHLEBOTOMY

Phlebotomy is a vital healthcare field that connects patient care with laboratory diagnosis. This program provides training in the safe and accurate collection of blood and other specimens through both classroom instruction and hands-on clinical experience. It offers a strong entry point into healthcare, leading to a stable career with opportunities for advancement.
